

St Mary's RC Primary School Key Stage Two National Assessment Results 2023

Below are the Key Stage Two outcome for 2023. There were 29 children in Year 6

The expected standard in the tests is a scaled score of 100 or above. The scaled score range is from 80 – 120. Writing Teacher Assessment is not converted to a scaled score. The national figures are also shown in the table below.

Interpreting progress scores:

Progress scores will be centred around 0, with most schools within the range of -5 to 5.

A score of 0 means children in this school on average do about as well at KS2 as those with a similar prior attainment.

A positive score means children in this school on average do better at KS2 as those with similar prior attainment.

A negative score means children in this school on average do worse at KS2 as those with similar prior attainment nationally.
