Welcome back to the new school year. I hope you have all had a lovely summer and managed to spend some quality family time together, either on holiday or at home.

A warm welcome to all of the new children and families who have joined our school this September. We welcome our new Reception and Nursery intakes as well as all those children who have started in our expanded SEN Unit. There are also a number of children who have joined us in KS1 and KS2. We also welcome Miss Horoszczak who has joined St. Mary's as our new Year 5 teacher and Miss Waite who has joined the EYFS team. I hope all your journeys through St. Mary's will be a fruitful one and each and every day you feel part of our school family.

As a lot of you will have purchased new uniforms, please ensure your child's name is clearly visible inside each piece of uniform. It really is heartbreaking when we have piles of lost property left in school and we cannot identify who it belongs to, so it is left unclaimed.

School Attendance and Term Time Holidays

The government changes around attendance at schools have now been implemented. Please note that only absences categorised as urgent and exceptional will be authorised. No term time holidays will be authorised. A copy of the school absence request form is on the school website and copies are available from the school office. Please provide adequate time for school to process the request.

It is worth noting that if your child arrives after 9:30am without valid reason (eg a medical appointment) this is classed as an unauthorised absence.

Penalty notices will be issued for any 10 unauthorised absences within a 10 week period. (this is equivalent to 5 schools days)

Penalty notices will rise to £160, per child, per parent. If paid within 21 days, this will be reduced to £80. If a second penalty notice is issued, this will be at £160 but will not have the option of being reduced.

A 3rd penalty notice cannot be issued within 3 years of the first one. If the threshold (10 sessions) is met for a 3rd time, this will result in prosecution.

Our attendance and punctuality at St. Mary's is good and for the vast majority of our families these changes will have no impact at all but one of our biggest issues is around holidays in school time – and following guidelines, I am never allowed to authorise holidays in school time.

Please note that if you child is ill prior to or directly after a school holiday, or a planned holiday of 4 days or less, school may ask for evidence of illness or flight details. This is to comply with government guidelines and also from a welfare point of view.

Nursery Places

We still have a few places available in our school nursery. If you wish you child to start in Nursery please contact the school office. Spaces are capped at 26. Once we reach this number we will no longer be able to admit more children.

Sacramental Programme

For pupils at St. Mary's who are Year 3 or above who would like to enrol on the sacramental programme for 2025-26, there is a meeting on Tuesday 17th September in the church hall. If you require any more information, Sr Delores is on the main school gate most mornings or Fr Joe is available after parish masses at weekend.

Safeguarding

Our safeguarding team at St. Mary's consists of Miss Johnson, Mr Knapper and myself. If you wish to discuss any concerns with us, please ask and at least one of us will be available. All of our staff are safeguard trained, and we are here to keep your children safe and happy at all times.

Don't Miss Out...

It may seem very early, but each year we have children who miss out on their first choice school because they miss the deadlines for applying for school places.

For children in Year 6 – the application window for high schools opens in early September and closes on the 31st October. More information will follow shortly.

For children in Nursery – The window for applications to Primary school opens in November and closes on the 15th January 2026. This year we had close to 70 applications for our 30 places. If your child attends St. Mary's Nursery – this does not automatically entitle you to a place in our Reception class. You must still apply via Tameside.

School Uniform and PE Kits

During Wednesday's assembly I spoke to all of the children about having pride in their uniform and how a school uniform lets everybody know that every child is on the same team. The children at St. Mary's have always looked smart in their uniforms and we need that to continue. The school uniform at St. Mary's is as follows:

Navy blue jumper or cardigan (with or without logo),
White shirt or blouse,
Grey trousers or skirt,
School tie, Black shoes

If your child has PE, they should come into school wearing their full PE kit: **White t shirt or polo shirt, navy blue shorts, trainers**. To keep warm, your child may also wear navy blue jogging pants and their school jumper / cardigan.

School Meals

The Autumn Term menu can be found at the end of the newsletter. We now have 4 options available for each day – a meat option, a vegetarian option, jacket potato or a sandwich. We also have a salad bar which children can help themselves to with a range of vegetables and fresh bread.

School lunches need to be pre-booked using the schoolgrid app or webpage. While the vast majority of parents have already prebooked meals, we currently have a small number of parents who have not registered and completed their child's profile. The number of meals cooked each day is based on the number of meals ordered. Although we would not let you child go hungry, if not prebooked, they may be limited to food choices which they would not pick themselves. Meals can be booked in advance – so there is no reason why you could not choose a weeks' worth of meals with your child at the weekend if you so wish!

Toasty Friday

Next Friday will see the return of the school favourite, Toasty Friday. If you would like your child to have a piece of toast at Break each Friday, the cost is £7.00 and this can be paid online at parentmail.

Of course the success of Toasty Friday very much depends on our volunteer help to make the toast. If you would be able to assist, then please contact the school office, to ask to be included on our Toasty Friday rota.

The online application facility will open for new Reception applications **early November 2025.**



The closing date for Primary School applications is **15 January 2026.**



Any application received after 15th January 2026 will be dealt with as a 'LATE' application and considered after those received on time.

If your child will be 11 before 1 September 2026



You should apply for a High School place through the Local Authority where you live.



Extra district residents will receive information on how to apply from their own Local Authority.



You must apply for a High School Year 7 place online through the Tameside MBC website at www.tameside.gov.uk



The online application facility will open for new Year 7 applications **early September 2025**.



The closing date for High School applications is **31 October 2025.**



Any application received after 31st October 2025 will be dealt with as a 'LATE' application and considered after those received on time.
