Punctuality

We have a number of children who are arriving at school late each morning. The school gates are open at 8:40am and registers are taken at 9:50am. We expect all children to be sat in class ready to start lessons at 8:50am. Please allow your children time to come into school, take of bags and coats and make their way into class. Even if the school gate is still open, your child will still get a late mark if they are not in class by 8:50am. If the gate is closed, children need to enter school via the main entrance.

Christmas Dinner

Although we are still in November, Christmas will soon be here! Our school Christmas Dinner is planned for 11th December – this is also Christmas Jumper Day. School Christmas Dinner can be ordered, and paid for, via the School Grid app. Please do this as soon as possible as the food has to be ordered by the catering team in advance.

Christmas Party Lunch

On December 19th the school kitchen will be cooking a party lunch instead of the usual meal selection. Lunch will consist of a selection of sandwiches, carrot and cucumber sticks, nachos, shortbread biscuits and fresh fruit. Lunch can be ordered via the school grid app or website in the usual way.

Don't Miss Out...

For children in Nursery – The window for applications to Primary school is now open and closes on the 15th January 2026. This year we had close to 70 applications for our 30 places. If your child attends St. Mary's Nursery – this does not automatically entitle you to a place in our Reception class. You must still apply via Tameside.

Nativity Concerts.

Next week, on Wednesday and Thursday, we will be holding our KS1 nativity concert in the school hall. The concert will start at 9:30am. Due to the way the hall is currently set out, parents entry is at the same side of the hall as the stage. Due to this, if you are late, you may be asked to wait until an appropriate time to enter the hall so you do not disturb the show. On the 9th and 11th we will be holding our EYFS nativity concert. The children are looking forward to performing for you all.
